TO: Karen Secotte, a resident of the Town of Lincolnville in the County of Waldo:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Lincolnville in said County and State, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to appear in the **Walsh Common of the Lincolnville Central School, 523 Hope Road in Lincolnville, Maine on Monday, February 12, 2018 at 6:00 PM**, then and there to act upon the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. To elect a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into an agreement with the Lincolnville Sewer District for the Town to contribute \$19,000 per year for ten years to help fund capital improvement upgrades to Lincolnville Sewer District's wastewater treatment facility, collection system and pump station at Lincolnville Beach, said agreement in substantially the same form as shown on the attached.
